



# Wey Valley Rifle & Pistol Club and 1760 HME PROCEDURE

If you have purchased a rifle that requires HME to shoot at Bisley  
the club requires the following to be followed.

To shoot at Bisley you will be required to take a NRA HME course at your own expense  
recently approx £35.00. You can then have HME on your SSC.

The next step on arrival is to go to the Range Office and show your SSC and collect  
a free blue HME card.

Go to the Zero Range and put 3 holes into the box at the 1000 yard settings.

This card is then signed on the left by the shooter and either:

On a club day, get a member who is an RSO with HME to sign the rest or take back to the  
Range Office to sign

On a private day take back to the Range Office.

***(Either way the card goes back to the Range Office before you shoot)***

Ask for a copy or take a picture as the club RSO will request to see this when you come  
to the firing point.

These rules have been set following a meeting with the NRA.
